FROM OUR OFFICE ADMINISTRATOR...

I have been reading 1 Samuel and 2 Samuel as part of my daily devotional since June, and I have once again been confronted with the issue of patience and waiting on the Lord. In 1 Samuel 13 Saul grew impatient waiting on Samuel who was late for an appointment to offer a sacrifice to the Lord, and he offered the offering himself. In verses 13-14 Samuel told Saul that his rash act had cost him his kingdom, and that "a man after God's heart" would be king.

David, on the other hand was patient beyond my current abilities. In 1 Samuel 16 David was anointed by Samuel as king over Israel, but he did not become king until 2 Samuel 2. Also, he was only king over Judah, and not king over all of Israel until 2 Samuel 5. During this time David had several opportunities to kill Saul and proclaim himself king, but he would not kill "God's anointed" and waited on the Lord to act. God had much to teach David, and patience was needed.

Well, what does all of this have to do with us? I submit to you that it has everything to do with us. The church staff is currently preparing a plan to restart Sunday School, Wednesday activities, committee meetings and many other activities and actions returning us to some level of normalcy. The temptation for all of us would be to move and act as soon as we can, but I believe God is teaching us that we should be prepared and act in His timing. Please pray for us as we make preparations to restart all we do as a church in a manner that will glorify the Lord, and that we will be prepared when the time comes.
