FROM OUR MUSIC WORSHIP LEADER:

Several weeks ago, we picked Mac up from the nursery after church and he was excited to show us his coloring sheet he'd completed in Sunday School. There was a picture of Jesus and a few disciples in a boat, with lightning bolts and rain falling from the sky. Jesus has been scribbled over with blue crayon, but that's neither here nor there.

As we were walking down the hallway, I asked Mac about his picture and he pointed to Jesus and told me what was going on in the picture. At lunch that day, we were getting Mac to retell his Bible story. It went a little something like this: "Jesus in the boat. His friends, too. There was funder (thunder) and lightning and rain in the sky." I asked if the friends were scared and what Jesus did to help them and he quickly responded with, "Jesus said, 'BE STILL! I don't like you storm!'"

Later that night as we were putting him to bed, we got out his Bible storybook and found the story he learned about that day in Sunday School. We sang a song or two and we put him to bed. The next morning, Drew asked Mac what he wanted for breakfast. Bacon, apple slices and milk are usually his go to, but not this particular morning. "I want Jesus" was his reply. In fact, everything we asked him that morning returned a plea of "give me Jesus" or "I want Jesus."

It got me to thinking a lot about what we really want in this world. We don't need hardly anything we have. We should simply want more Jesus. On Sunday, the choir will lead in worship with the special, "Give Me Jesus." The chorus is simple, "Give me Jesus, give me Jesus, you can have all this world, give me Jesus." The Lord is the only thing that could ever save and satisfy us—not our possessions, status, relationships, residence, or anything else.
