## FROM OUR SENIOR PASTOR...

The Advent theme for this week is *HOPE*. If there's one outlook our world is displaying right now it is hope. In the midst of a global pandemic, hope is what our hearts long for, isn't it? Let's ask the simple question, "What is hope?" Most often biblical hope gets confused with optimism. Optimism is displaying a positive outlook in the midst of whatever the circumstances may be. But is this biblical hope? No. The hope of optimism is that circumstances will eventually get better. But, what if a person's circumstances never get better? Are they left without hope? Absolutely not!

Paul says in Romans 15:13, "Now may the God of hope fill you with all joy and peace as you believe so that you may overflow with hope by the pow-

er of the Holy Spirit" (CSB).

As much as we want to see a vaccine to this virus, biblical hope is not found in a pill but in a person. If you want to overflow with biblical hope then you need to know the God of hope. Peter says that in Christ, we are born again into a living hope (1 Pt. 1:3). In light of Jesus' resurrection, we have a living and lasting hope, no matter our circumstances. Do we want things to get better? Sure we do. Would we like to see a return to normalcy or to hear the doctor say "The cancer is gone"? Absolutely. But remember, our hope is not anchored in what our circumstances may or may not be. We have a living hope, and it is anchored in Jesus himself.

How can you display this kind of hope in your life? What would it mean for your relationships if you injected this kind of hope into them? I'm praying for us all as we point others to Jesus, the source of our true and lasting hope.
