**FROM OUR SENIOR PASTOR...**

*8Oh give thanks to the LORD; call upon his name; make known his deeds among the peoples! 9Sing to him, sing praises to him; tell of all his wondrous works! 10Glory in his holy name; let the hearts of those who seek the LORD rejoice! 11Seek the LORD and his strength; seek his presence continually! 12Remember the wondrous works that he has done, his miracles and judgments he utter..." 1 Chronicles 16:8-12 (ESV)*

Can't you feel the excitement in King David's song here? This kind of song invigorates God's people to rejoice in who God is, what He has said, and what He has done. David wrote this worship song to be sung on the occasion of moving the ark of God to the city of David, Jerusalem. This was not the usual worship service the Jews would've routinely experienced. This was something special!

Not every worship service will contain the same level of wonder and excitement. Maybe they should be, but that's not the normal experience. However, there are those times in the history of a worshipping community when there is an elevated sense of expectation and wonder. I believe this coming Sunday morning is one of those times. As we get ready to close a chapter in the history of Highland, we do not do it with fear and anxiety, but with awe and wonder. Awe and wonder at what God has done in the past with his people in Highland and great expectation at what He will do in the days ahead.

This Sunday will be our last Sunday to gather in the sanctuary as it is. Come June, we will move into the FLC until the renovation project is complete. I believe the best way for us to close this chapter is to do what King David called the people he led to do: **Remember what God has done and REJOICE!** That's what we are commanded to do in the Bible and it's what we want to do this Sunday. We will have times of remembrance during the service through songs, prayers, stories, preaching of God's word, and the Lord's Supper. Come expecting to experience God through His marvelous, wondrous, and glorious work through Jesus and in us this Sunday!
