Trunks and Jesus

Everyone needs an excuse to dress up in a funny costume or stuff their cars with crazy decorations. Clint finds me dressed up in random costumes all the time when I'm going through a closet in the Children's Department. Well, I have the perfect opportunity to dress yourself, your family, and/or your car in crazy costumes and decorations. We are doing a Trunk or Treat on October 31 from 4:00 PM until 6:00 PM in Highland's lower parking lot!

Trunk or Treat will be filled with so many trunks, so much candy, so much fellowship, and so much Jesus. This year's Trunk or Treat will include a dinner fundraiser for kids going to Centrikid Camps in July, 100 trunks (where 14 of those trunks will be a walkthrough of Jesus's life), endless Gospel conversations, and fellowship with new and old friends. Kids will begin Trunk or Treat with visiting my trunk where I will welcome the kids and give instructions, from there they will move to the basic trunks, then arrive at the "walkthrough Jesus's life" trunks, and then end at David telling the kids the Gospel at his trunk.
