FROM OUR SENIOR PASTOR...

"The best way to garden is to put on a wide-brimmed straw hat and some old clothes. And with a hoe in one hand and a cold drink in the other, tell somebody else where to dig." (Texas Bix Bender, Don't Throw in the Trowel)

Gardening is a lot like the biblical concept of revitalization. We all want the produce without the work.

To revitalize means "to give new life and vitality to" (Concise Oxford Dictionary). After Israel went into captivity to the Babylonians and then the Persians, God moved in the heart of a servant named Nehemiah. Nehemiah was the cup-bearer to King Artaxerxes. When Nehemiah heard that Jerusalem still lied in ruins, his heart was broken and he began to pray for an opportunity to serve the Lord. Several months later, God gave him the opportunity to travel to Jerusalem and to begin the revitalization effort. Before he began, he surveyed the work and then spoke to the people. Nehemiah said,

"You see the trouble we are in, how Jerusalem lies in ruins with its gates burned. Come, let us build the wall of Jerusalem, that we may no longer suffer derision." And I told them of the hand of my God that had been upon me for good, and also of the words that the king had spoken to me. And they said, "Let us rise up and build." So they strengthened their hands for the good work. (Neh. 2:17-18, ESV)

Nehemiah was broken over the ruined city of God. He surveyed the problem, displayed great faith and, then invited others to serve with him. They brought new life to Jerusalem because they served. Are you broken over our city's spiritual needs? Jesus has called and commissioned us to serve the city and its inhabitants (Matt. 28:19-20; Acts 1:8). We are to be salt and light; a city on a hill to shine the light of the gospel (Matt. 5:13-16). Will you lead by serving? Will you work for the spiritual vitality of our city and county? 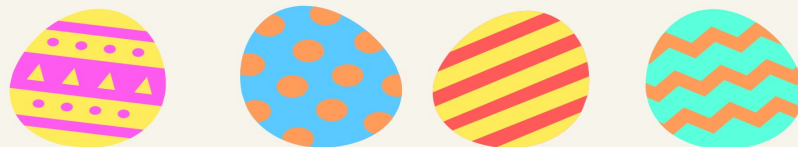
