FROM OUR SENIOR PASTOR...

If someone asked you, "What would you say are two or three most important priorities for Christians to pursue in terms of their faith?" how would you answer? This was one of the questions posed in a 2007 survey by the Barna Research Group to born-again Christians. The top responses were "doing the right thing/not sinning (37%) and learning about Christ and about the Bible (31%). Those are not bad things at all and should be present in a believer's life. The problem is that the lowest ranking priority with 1% was "family faith—discipling your children." Here's the deal. Jesus told us to go to the ends of the earth to make disciples. Jesus DOES want us to make disciples around the world but it starts at home (Acts 1:8). Our job as parents and grandparents is to teach our kids and grandkids how to follow Jesus. I truly believe that one of the primary reasons this priority ranked so low is that most believing parents just don't know how to do that...and that's okay. It's okay to realize that, but not okay to stay that way.

If you are a parent and grandparent and you have not signed up for our Parenting Conference yet, I encourage you; I implore you, do it now. We have the privilege of having one of the leading voices on children/teen/parent discipleship leading this conference. Make no mistake, our kids and grandkids are being disciplined. If you and I won't do it, then someone else will. Let's build spiritually-strong kids and teens together. I can't wait for this weekend, and I can't wait to see you there and engaged!

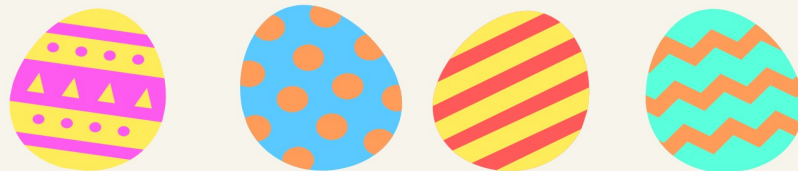
