FROM OUR STUDENT MINISTER...

I read an article recently where it listed off the top 8 most popular things to collect and, other than baseball cards, I never got into any of them. In fact, when I was doing research on why people collect items, what I found was "some people do it for pleasure; others to learn more about the objects; others seek status or prestige and many do it to show loyalty..." Based on these reasons for being a collector, it makes sense that I would have had dozens of collections in my life. However, this hobby has never been a part of me.

So, as I said, I have recently decided to start a collection. Not anything that might someday become valuable. I am not collecting anything that I can pass down to my children one day. It is something that is practical, something that I use every day, and something that I feel represents a major passion in my life. I have begun collecting coffee mugs! My prayer is that He will be in a public, prominent place in your life and you will never grow tired of talking about Him to the people around you.
