### FROM OUR SENIOR PASTOR...

Conflict is the stuff of life. Other than the bookend chapters in the Bible (Gen. 1-2 and Rev. 21-22), the rest of the Bible is filled with conflict. But, conflict doesn't have to be all bad. Did you know that God is so awesome that He uses conflict for His purposes and our good? Not just for any kind of good, but God introduced conflict for His redemptive purposes. This does mean that God caused sin. The Bible is very clear that Adam and Eve's disobedience caused the curse, but God took advantage of conflict and used it for His redemptive purposes in our lives. Here, let me show you.

God said to the serpent...

*"I will put enmity between you and the woman, and between your offspring and her offspring; he shall bruise your head, and you shall bruise his heel" (Gen. 3:15, ESV)*

God put conflict between the serpent and woman's offspring so that redemption would be possible. The woman's offspring here is Jesus Christ. In his manifold power and wisdom, God takes the conflict that we endure and fulfills His redemptive purposes through them. Through the greatest conflict of all time, Jesus' death on the cross, God has accomplished His redemptive purpose in our lives.

When someone comes to faith in Christ, conflict with God is resolved by the cross in salvation.

When a Christian adopts a baby that would've otherwise been aborted, conflict is resolved by giving life.

When a believer disagrees with another believer, the conflict between the two is resolved in looking to the interest of the other like Jesus did for us (Phil. 2:4).

Over the last two weeks we have looked at different angles of conflict. There are many in our church and around us who need us to walk with them and encourage them that God has plans for our pains. He has redemption in mind. God doesn't want conflict to use us. Instead, He can use our conflict for His glory and our good.
