October is upon us, which means that Trunk or Treat is right around the corner! Last year at Trunk or Treat, I was blown away. So many kids and parents learned so much about Jesus that night, and so I cannot wait to see the work that the Lord does through our Trunk or Treat this year.

Trunk or Treat will be Sunday, October 30th from 4:00 until 6:00 PM in our lower parking lot. Before it gets here, I need your help in a few ways:

1. I need candy, candy, and more candy. Every time you go to the grocery store, pick up some candy. Every time you order something from amazon, add some candy to your cart. (If you want to buy the biggest bags of candy, check out Oriental Trading online.) You can drop the candy off in the white laundry baskets that are spread throughout Highland.
2. I need Trunks. Trust me, you want to come to Trunk or Treat and you want to decorate a trunk. Sign your trunk up by clicking on "Trunk Sign Up- Trunk or Treat" on our Church App or at my Trunk or Treat bulletin board outside the sanctuary. There are a few different options that you can choose from with the trunks:
 - A. Jesus Trunks: These are 12 trunks that walk-through Jesus' life. It starts at His birth and ends at His resurrection. I give you a piece a paper that you read to the kids as they come to your trunk, I tell you a theme to decorate your trunk like, and you give every kid a piece of candy. It's so easy, but oh-so important! I *need you* to do this trunk.
 - B. Classic Car Trunk: If you have a classic or a cool car, sign up! Throw some streamers on your trunk, and you're ready! Everyone loves to look at cool cars.
 - C. Game Trunk: If you want to do a game at your trunk like Go-Fish, or a Cake Walk, or any simple game, sign up for a game trunk!
 - D. Basic Trunk: If you want to spend hours decorating to have the best-looking trunk, or if you just simply want to throw a blue tarp in the trunk and say that it's a beach, then sign up for this trunk! You'll love the fellowship that you'll be able to have at Trunk or Treat.
