

If you do not currently participate on Wednesday nights I highly encourage you to jump in anytime! K-6 have 3 more worship rallies that include a theme as well as the addition of POINTS. Starting next week, every Wednesday I will be making a checklist of points, and on May 22 we will announce the grand prize winner at our W.O.W. finale night. Notice, the biggest way to earn points is by bringing a friend to worship rally or any children's events. HBC is redirecting our focus on reaching out!

During the first 15 minutes beginning at 5:45pm, we have started a prayer journal and the kids will be focusing on prayer and memorizing a verse a month. The verse a month will allow time to really discuss that verse's meaning and may it hide in their hearts for when they need it. We will also work to memorize the Old Testament books of the Bible using a fun form of sign language. This will be a tool they will use the rest of their lives. Every week your child has the opportunity to lead us in prayer and read the Bible out loud. They are brainstorming where they would like to serve in the church when they grow up. Game nights are back on the schedule and will also include pre-k classes. Pre -K will have a special Paint Night with me on Feb. 20!

Many of our children have questions and have baptism on their hearts, and this allowed them to dig into what it's all about. It was great! Please know that Clint and I are both eager and ready to talk with any children in making a profession of faith.
