

Following 3 days of this I was angry that I didn't get anything out of it and I only get one budgeted opportunity a year. Then we both concluded that this is exactly what the Lord wanted us to see.

It was a wake up call for us as well as a reminder to be aware of false prophets or just leaving God out, even in the world of ministry. It's not all good, so keep close with the Holy Spirit in helping you discern what is and what isn't. Like I said, they did nothing wrong, but maybe it's what they didn't do that was wrong.
