

A friend of mine "commented" on a video of CeCe Winans singing "Blessed Assurance" at a Kennedy Center Honors performance and it came up on my newsfeed. I, of course, stopped what I was doing and watched the entire video.

"Blessed Assurance" is one of the hymns I remember singing growing up. I don't know that I was terribly impacted by the lyrics, but I loved the rhythm of the song.
