FROM OUR INTERIM PASTOR...

If you’ve been watching the news, then you’ve seen how tornadoes have devastated parts of Texas and Oklahoma. On Tuesday, May 27, 1997, a F-5 tornado obliterated Jarrell, Texas. Its damage path measured ¾ mile wide and 7.6 miles long. Its winds, greater than 260 MPH, upended 50,000 lb. garbage trucks, stripped asphalt from roads, and uprooted plumbing. Twenty-seven people died in less than thirty minutes. Tornadoes wreck millions of dollars of property in the United States annually. They are real-life “monsters” Big. Loud. Scary. Deadly. Nature’s most destructive forces, however, are small and not frightening at all: insects, water, salt, rust, mold, mildew, and fungus. We know to fear giants. Too often, we underestimate germs. Highland Baptist Church is not buildings but a living, growing family. We’re flesh and blood, muscle and bone. United, we’re mighty but not almighty. Together, we shall be victorious yet still vulnerable. Tornadoes such as government persecution and heresy may strike. More likely, we will contend with termites; subtle foes such as gossip, whining, unjust criticism, and worldliness that penetrate, burrow, infest, and fester, causing distractions, divisions, delays, decay, and disabilities. We know to fear giants. Don’t underestimate germs. “Therefore, putting aside all malice and all guile and hypocrisy and envy and all slander, like newborn babes, long for the pure milk of the word, that by it you may grow in respect to salvation, if you have tasted the kindness of the Lord.” (1 Pet. 2:1-3)
