FROM OUR MUSIC WORSHIP LEADER...

July 18th is a night that we're setting aside to do a FREE PARENTS NIGHT OUT for our CDC families of children ages 2-4. We'll have an ice cream sundae party, arts & crafts, a Bible story and fun and games from 6:30-9:00.

As you can see, "I Need Somebody" to HELP! My goal is to have every Sunday school class participate in some way! In addition to the things we are responsible for, there are ways to get involved in showing random acts of kindness on Monday of that week, working in schools on Wednesday of that week doing painting, organizing, prayer walking, etc., and helping with a camp at the Boys and Girls Club on Friday. If you want to serve, there's an opportunity to get involved and you can join a group each morning when we all gather at Oak Hill Baptist Church for morning devotional.

There's another great part of that week- gathering together with hundreds of people at the Temple Theater on Sunday, Wednesday and Friday night of that week to worship!
