FROM OUR CHILDREN'S DIRECTOR...

Dear Highland Baptist Church,

Sunday, September 15th will be my last day to serve as Children's Director. I want to thank you for allowing me to serve the church and giving me a chance to answer the Lord's call. It was something He placed on my heart for months after Bro. Carl mentioned the need from the pulpit. Honestly, it never crossed my mind before, that I could actually do something like that, and be very good at it. All I knew was that I loved the Lord with great passion, and I could not wait to share that with the children. I knew I wanted to begin by just letting them see Jesus through me, and how to be fearless and bold in worshiping HIM.
