## FROM OUR MUSIC WORSHIP LEADER...

“Bridge the Gap.” Those were the three words that came right out of my mouth in a meeting back in August when I shared a vision for Adopt the Heart of a CDC Family. In that meeting, I told the CDC teachers that this ministry was a way for our church to “bridge the gap” and form a prayer partnership with the families that walk through the doors each day. In the weeks that followed, the staff has used those same three words, jokingly, to express ways our church can be involved in the community, but it got me to thinking about the meaning behind that phrase.

Highland has already started a partnership with West Hills Elementary School through the Hope Packs Ministry, and we are excited to start a Reading Ministry with the 2<sup>nd</sup> grade students soon. Will you agree to come and receive a FREE LUNCH next Thursday, October 24<sup>th</sup>, and learn more about this reading ministry? I promise that our time together will be beneficial, you'll have a chance to ask any questions, and I hope you'll prayerfully consider making the commitment to one child at West Hills. Reading for 30 minutes a week, at your convenience, is an easy way for our church to bridge the gap and continue on our path to becoming an externally focused church.
