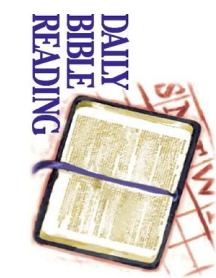

FROM OUR MINISTER TO STUDENTS...

Favorite... This is a word that, maybe more so than any other word in our language, can be divisive amongst the closest of friends, even among family members. Don't believe me? Pay attention to Facebook on Thanksgiving. Lifelong friends will be at each other's throats over the MS State vs Ole Miss football game simply because their favorite teams are playing each other. I've seen debates break out over people having different favorite books, movies, guns, schools, and so much more. I once got into a pretty heated debate over which type of candy is best. I was taking a hard stance that Reese's Peanut Butter Cups were better than any other type of chocolate. I have felt that way since childhood. When I was a child, I remember watching TV and seeing the Reese's commercials saying, "There's no wrong way to eat a Reese's." Most of you probably remember that slogan. However, most of you probably didn't test that theory. My brother and I tried multiple ways to eat the candy. We tried without hands, with the paper still on it, throwing it at each other, and so on. And behold, I am with you always, to the end of the age.'" There's no wrong way to share Christ. Just take a deep breath, realize who God has placed in front of you, and start talking about Jesus.
