#### FROM OUR MINISTER TO STUDENTS..

"Balls and strikes, safe and out, any judgement calls are mine and my partner's call. Arguing them won't do you any good. However, if you have any questions about a non-judgment ruling, call time out when the ball is dead, and we'll talk about it. Now, are all your players safely and properly equipped?"

When I was three years old, the tee ball program in Prentiss (where I grew up) didn't quite have enough players to fill as many teams as they wanted so a few dads were called to see if their sons wanted to play a year earlier than they were technically allowed to play. My dad, being a sports nut, was quick to answer yes and my baseball career began then in 1989. Fast forward to 2004, I'm still playing. I'm a senior in high school and that was the last time I played organized baseball. I knew I wasn't good enough to play at the collegiate level, so I found another way to stay close to the game. I began umpiring little league. After a couple years, I was asked to begin umpiring some jr. high ball. After that, I started doing high school ball. To this day, I still umpire in the spring. It serves a couple purposes. One: it gives us a little extra spending money. Two (and most importantly): it keeps me close to a game that I love being around. The paragraph at the top of this article is a portion of what I'm supposed to say to the head coaches during our pre-game meeting. We go over a few rules, exchange line ups, shake hands, and then we play ball. I love every aspect of it. I don't even mind getting ribbed by fans after they disagree with a call I make. I just enjoy being around the game and I made an effort to keep it in my life.

I feel certain that this attitude is shared by each and every one of us. Maybe not toward baseball or any other sport, but definitely toward something. If we are passionate about something, if this particular thing is important to us, we find a way to be around it. We find a way to keep it in my life. Too many of us will claim that Jesus and the church is important to us, but we don't make any effort to be around it. We claim to love Christ but are we really living in a way that exemplifies that? Do we make the effort? The beautiful thing about our salvation is that there is nothing we can do to earn it. We can't win it. We can't work hard enough for it. Jesus just offers Himself freely to us. However, after salvation, it DOES take effort to continue to walk in Him. It DOES take effort to grow in Him. It DOES take effort, just like any other relationship, to keep close to Him. What are you doing to build that relationship? Are you spending time daily in the Scriptures? Are you spending time in prayer? Are you making an effort to be not just a member of Highland, but invested in the ministries here?

**CONTINUED...** 2 Peter 3 commands us to "grow in the grace and knowledge of our Lord and Savior Jesus Christ. To him be the glory both now and to the day of eternity." That is my prayer for you today. Make the effort to grow in Christ now and "to the day of eternity."
