FROM OUR SENIOR PASTOR..

God is at work here in Highland and we want to praise Him for working! When we devote ourselves to preaching the gospel, to worshipping Him in spirit and truth, to growing as disciples, and to reaching the lost, God will continue to work in us, among us, and through us.

As we begin month three of 2020, I want to encourage you to "get in the game" with gospel conversations! It's not as difficult as you might think.

In a recent survey by Lifeway, they found that 55% of people who attended church at least once a month have not shared with someone how to become a Christian in the past six months. However, 55% say they have invited an unchurched person to a church service or program in the past six months (Lifeway, April 23, 2019).

For some, an invitation to a worship service may be where you need to begin. That's great! Invite your friend, co-worker or neighbor, but go the next step and see if they will come with you. Go to lunch afterwards and ask good follow-up questions about the sermon.

For others, I want to encourage you to have a gospel conversation this week. In North American Mission Board's Evangelism Resource Guide 2020, two-time Super-Bowl-winning NFL coach Tony Dungy shared fives ways that you can share your faith and represent Jesus wherever you are.

- 1. Remember Colossians 3:23. "Whatever you do, do it as unto the Lord." Whatever you are doing and wherever you are, you are ultimately serving the Lord; be it at work or helping your neighbor.
- 2. Don't forget about grace. Follow Jesus' example and balance truth and grace. Speak the truth in love but also give grace to those who need it as God has given grace to you.
- 3. Always be ready to demonstrate. Dungy writes, "Once I demonstrated to my players I was in their corner, they listened to what I had to say—not just about football, but life, the Lord and everything else."
- 4. Keep respect as a staple of all interactions. Not everyone will share your Christian views. "You can have and share your beliefs and still demonstrate God's love even in the midst of disagreement."
- 5. Be ready to be the example. Again Dungy writes, "The world is watching us, and Jesus says we have to be different. As more hostility sets in, it's going to cause Christians to make a decision. Are we going to serve the Lord and show people the Christlike example of how to handle disagreements, or are we going to give in to hostility? We can't do that if we're going to be Christ's example."
