CONTINUING IMPROVEMENT

The staff of Highland Baptist Church is firmly committed to the concept of continual improvement which in its most basic expression means that we should never be satisfied with the status quo. This applies to worship, discipleship, music, preaching, teaching, service, buildings, security ... If the goal is to "maintain" we will inevitably decline, but if the goal is to "improve" we greatly increase the probability that we will indeed improve. I would like to share three areas in which we are currently placing great emphasis.

SECURITY

We have just recently completed a project in conjunction with the security property committees. The status (locked/unlocked) of the locks on the exterior doors at the sanctuary and fellowship hall can be viewed and changed remotely as well as programmed to lock and unlock at pre-determined times. We are no longer dependent on someone remembering to lock and check each door, and all of these locks can be "locked down" with a single click from a smartphone in the case of a security issue.

BUILDING

I am sure that you have noticed that some of the classrooms at HBC have newly painted walls and carpet. This is the completion of phase I of a multiple phase program to both maintain and improve our facilities. We will be addressing carpet and air conditioning issues in the sanctuary in the very near future.

DISCIPLESHIP

The "Dream Team" is focused on defining and implementing a path for discipleship that clearly defines the path available for a Christian to grow and make other disciples. The profession of faith and baptism is the beginning of the Christian's journey, not the end.
