FROM OUR SENIOR PASTOR...

What is your mission as a Christian? What is the mission of the Church? What is the mission of Highland Baptist Church? These are huge questions that all have the same answer.

Bring new people to Jesus and help them grow into Christ-like maturity. Or **make disciples who make disciples.**

In Matthew 28:19-20, Jesus said, "*Go therefore and make disciples of all nations, baptizing them in the name of the Father and of the Son and of the Holy Spirit, teaching them to observe all that I have commanded you. And behold, I am with you always, to the end of the age*" (ESV).

Jesus' goal for his people is to make disciples and this takes place through the process of discipleship. Eugene Peterson once wrote, "Discipleship is anything that causes what is believed in the heart to have demonstrable consequences in our daily life." In other words, what we believe is how we behave. We want to help people come to know the Lord, to grow in Christ-like character, so that their behavior will reflect the grace of Christ in their lives.

Here at Highland there are many great ways to continue to grow as a disciple, but here are two NEW ways.

Highland Kidz Worship

Beginning Sunday morning, September 1, we will have a special time of continued worship and teaching for our kids in grades 1st through 3rd. What better way to help our kids learn the gospel, respond to the gospel, and see them grow in the gospel than with a kid-friendly environment focused on making disciples of our kids on their level? Our kids will worship with all of us until the offering. At that time, you will see a slide on the screen inviting all kids 1st – 3rd grade to Highland Kidz Worship. They will all walk together to the Children's Ministry large room, and parents may check their children out from this location after the morning worship service.

Life Groups

On September 8, at 5 PM, we will kick off our brand new Life Groups. Life Groups are discipleship-focused small groups that meet typically in someone's home.
